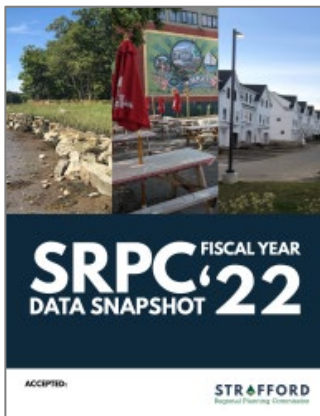
SRPC Regional Data Snapshot

SRPC conducts region-wide analysis of a number of data metrics each year for different projects and plans. The Regional Data Snapshot was a new document in 2021, and updated in April of each year, that contains many of these analyses in one place. Educational Attainment of Adults Over 25



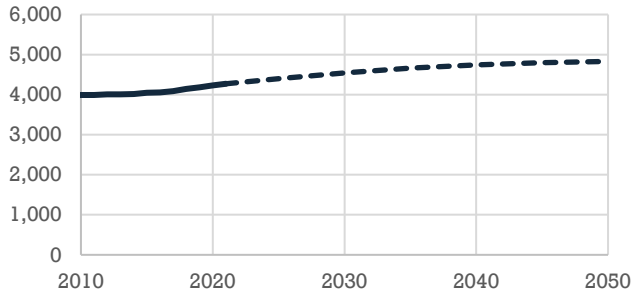
Public School Enrollment

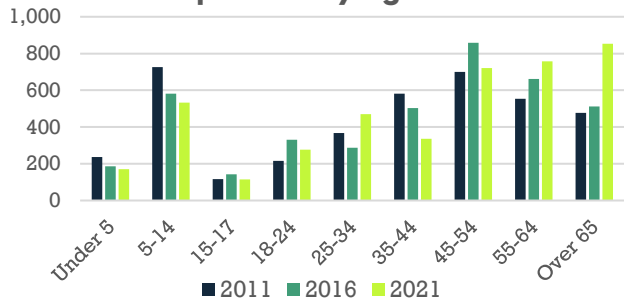

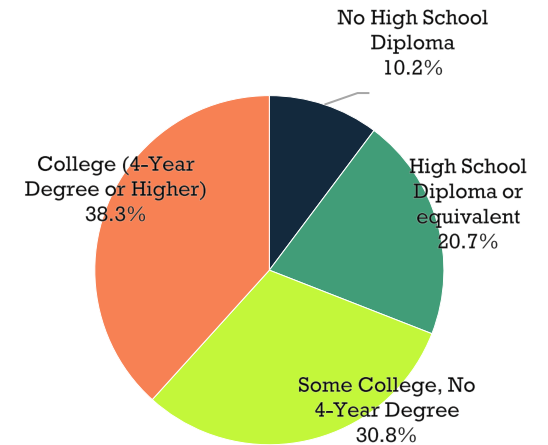

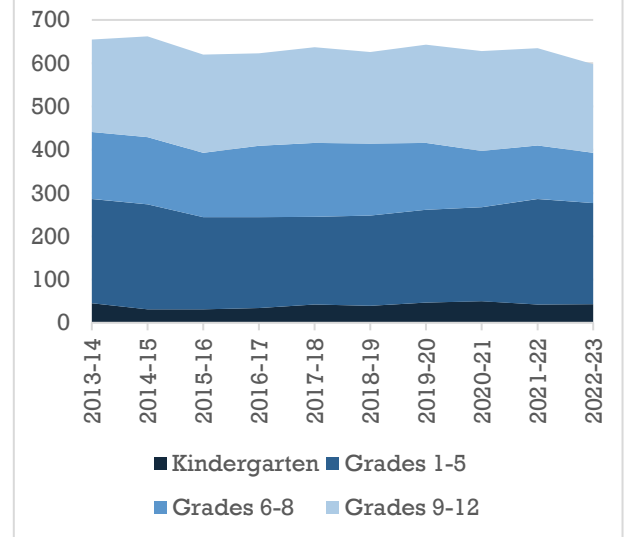

Educational Attainment of Adults Over 25



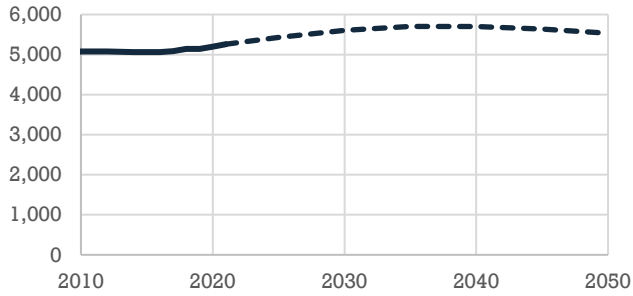
Public School Enrollment

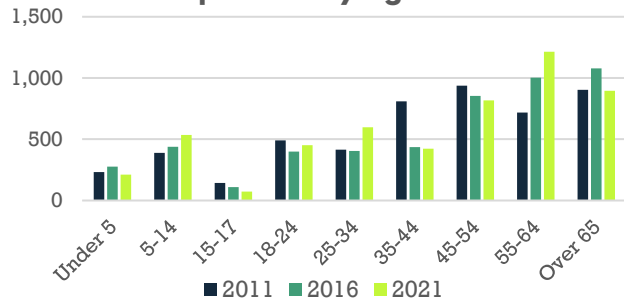

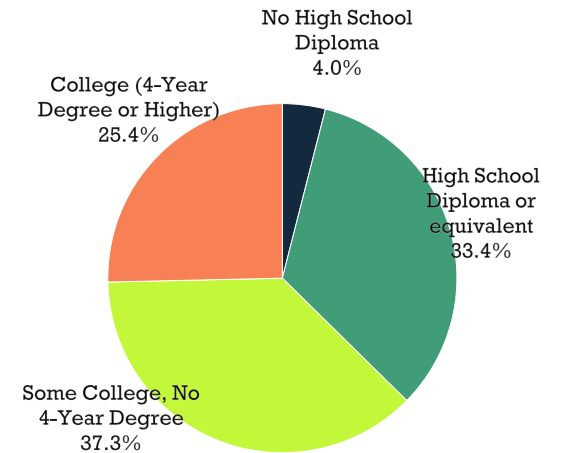
