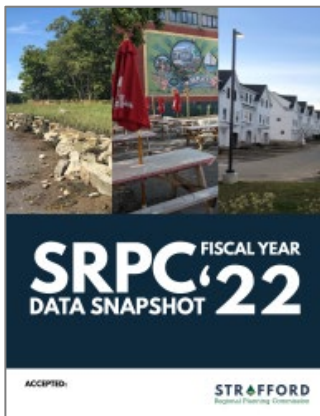
SRPC Regional Data Snapshot

SRPC conducts region-wide analysis of a number of data metrics each year for different projects and plans.
