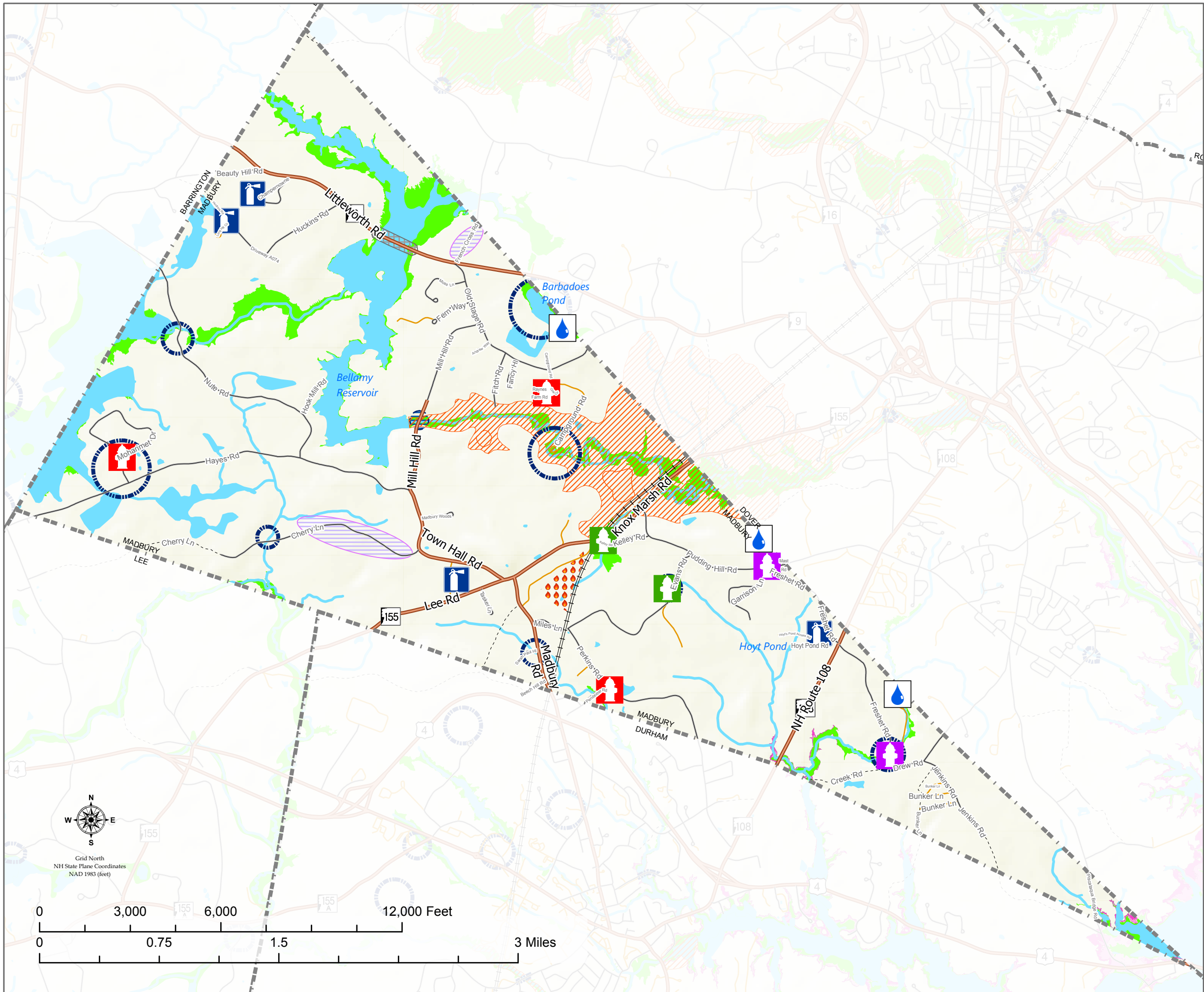

Water Resources (WR)

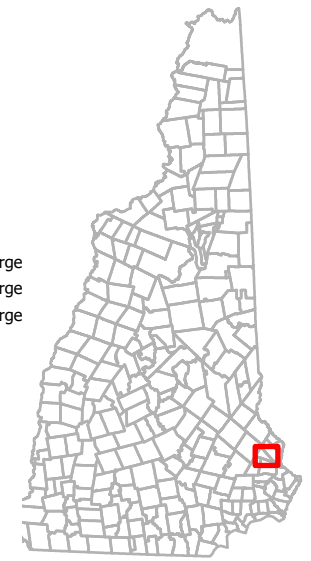
