SRPC Regional Data Snapshot

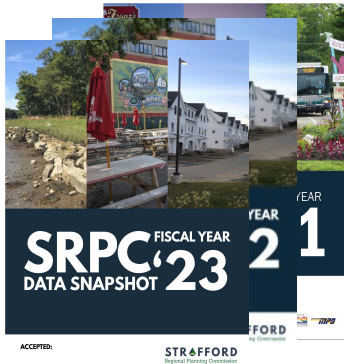
This document is a component of the SRPC Regional Data Snapshot.

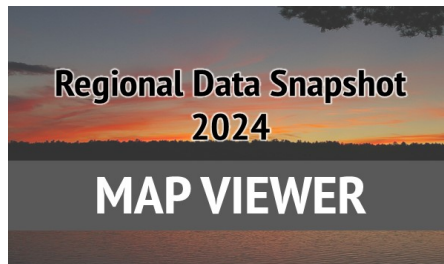

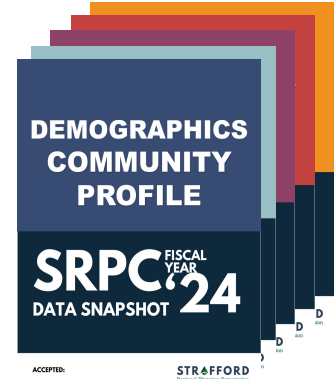

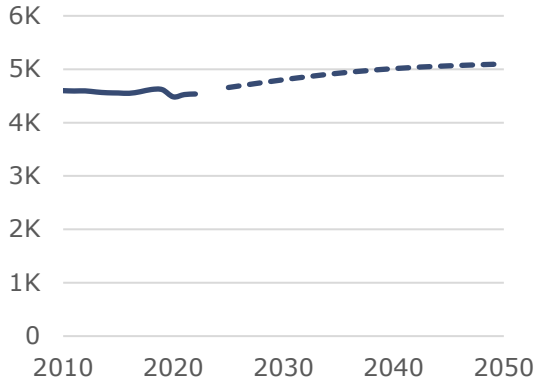
Future editions of the Data Snapshot will include the following changes:

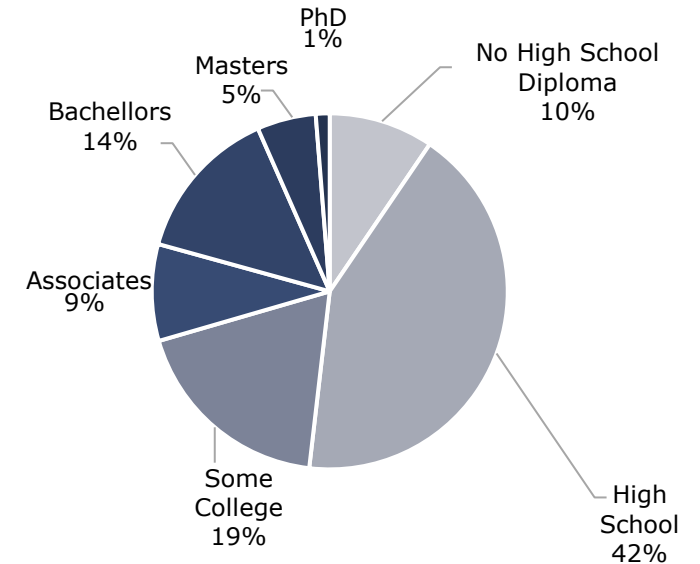
Population by Sex



Population by Race

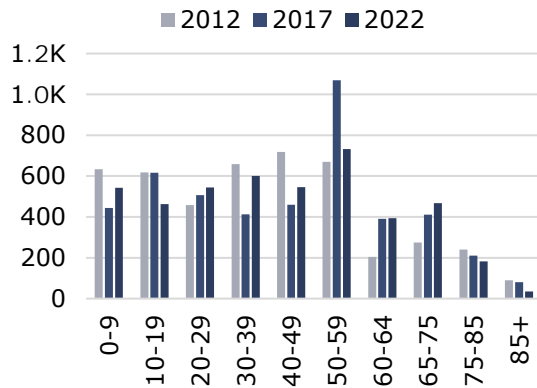

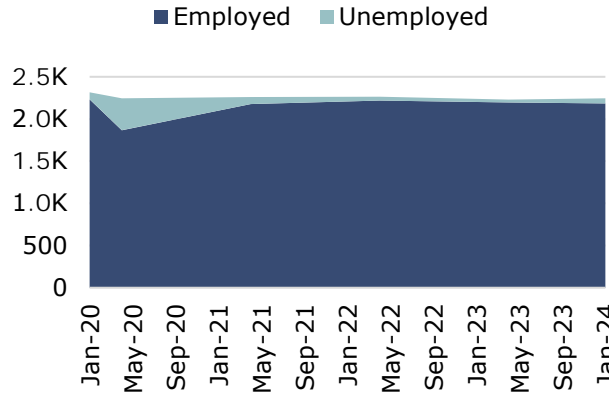

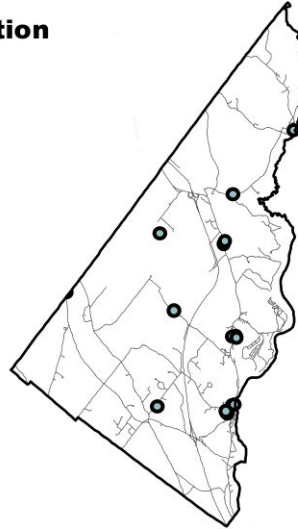
Traffic Safety (2013-2022)

Fatal Crashes



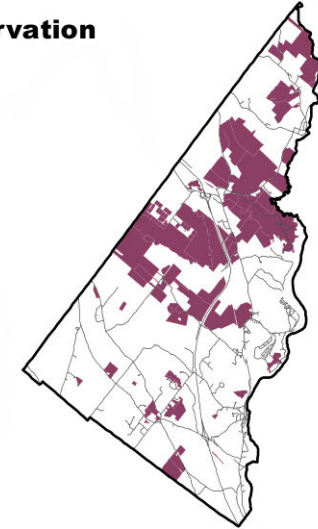

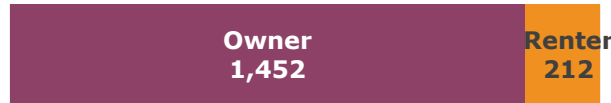

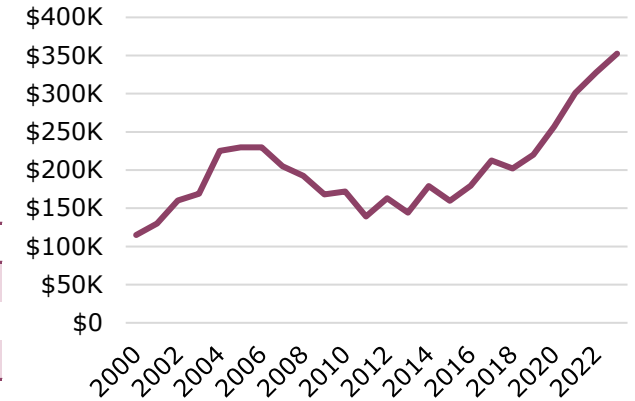

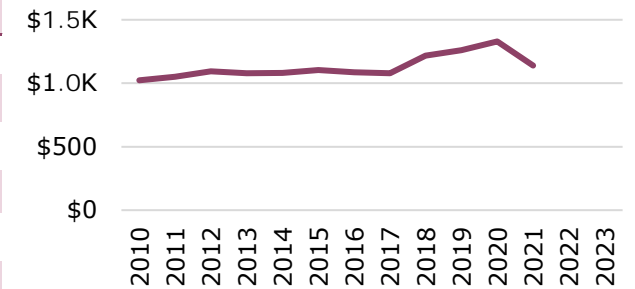

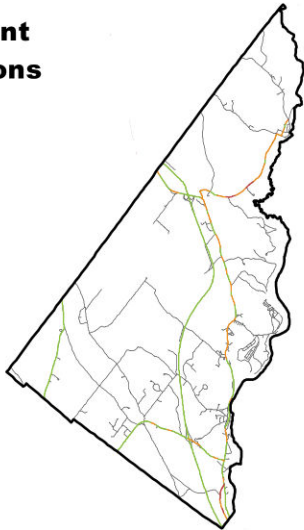

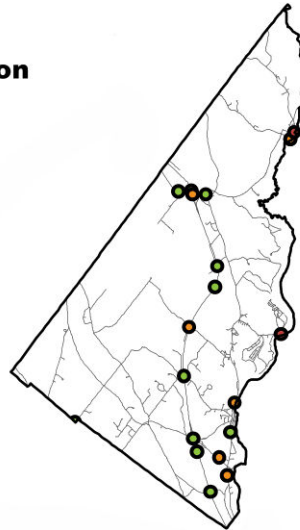

Pavement Conditions



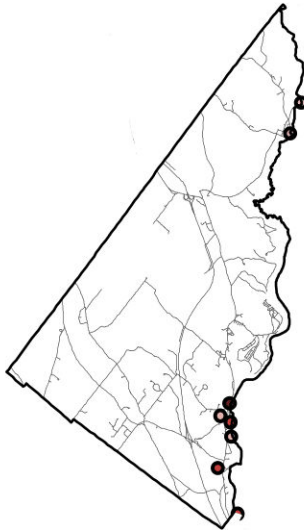
Bridge Condition



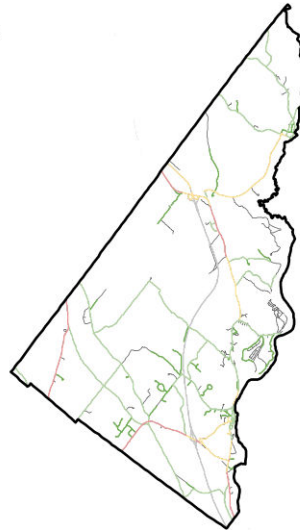

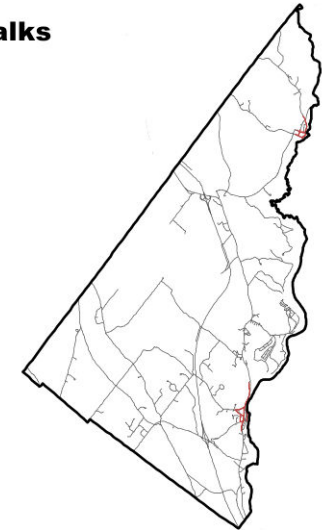

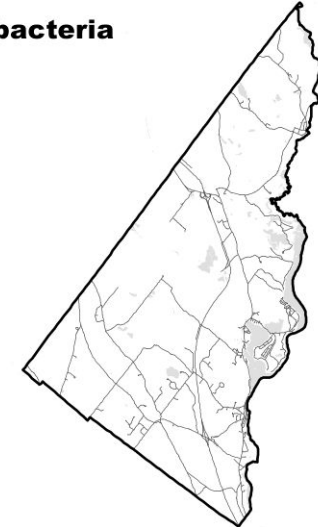

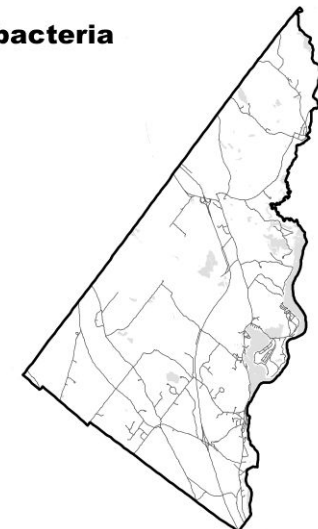
